## 1. What is the incident? Where did it happen?

The 7.7-magnitude earthquake that struck central Myanmar on March 28, 2025, had a devastating impact on the Inle Lake region in Nyaungshwe Township, Shan State. Initial reports indicate that at least 36 people lost their lives in Nyaungshwe Township, including villages around Inle Lake, and over 500 homes were destroyed. However, due to limited communication, we have not been able to collect accurate data yet. The earthquake caused widespread devastation, displacing thousands of families, damaging homes, and submerging essential infrastructure. The situation is especially dire, with communities left in crisis and livelihoods shattered. We have never faced anything like this before. The people of Inle, like many across Myanmar, are still in urgent need of support, especially temporary shelter, food and medicine.

### 2. How many people affected?

Nyaungshwe Township consists of 35 village tracts with 445 villages, home to 38,438 households and a population of approximately 167,257 people. Of these, 177 villages, 20,727 households, 17,832 homes, and around 74,212 individuals were directly affected by the earthquake. Additionally, many internally displaced persons (IDPs) who had previously fled to the area due to conflict are now unable to return home, further compounding the humanitarian crisis.

#### 3. What are the needs?

Food, Medicine especially for skins diseases, Hygiene Products and Drinking Water

#### 4. What is your response plan?

Distribution of rice, cooking oil, other essential food items, basic medicines, and hygiene products was carried out for 500 households across three villages.
